### Game/Activity:

#### Hosanna Banner

You will need: Everyone gets a Hosanna sheet and decorates with paint and pater.

Prepare plates with green paint and ask each person to then place their hand into the paint and then opening their fingers wide like a palm branch to print their hand print onto the sheeting. It is good if some overlap too as it creates even larger palm fronds!

Once hands are clean, give each person a sheet of green paper and ask them to draw around their open hand and then cut it out and lay it to one side.

Talk about Jesus riding into Jerusalem and the people shouting 'Hosanna!' as they welcomed their Jesus as a king. Ask everyone to write their names on the hand they have cut out and add it to the banner with sticky dots as a sign that they too are welcoming Jesus.

#### Palm-tastic!

You will need: paper sheets, tape, green tissue paper.

Have the children make simple palm branches to wave by rolling up paper sheets to make a branch and then sticking strips of green tissue paper at one end for the leaves.
