Closing Exhortations

4 Therefore, my dear brothers whom I long for, my joy and my victor's crown, this is how you must stand firm in the Lord, dear friends. **2** I urge Euodia and Syntyche to have the same attitude in the Lord. **3** Yes, I also ask you, my true partner,^[a] to help these women.
